

Thank you for your request for information regarding any persons employed by the Committee on Standards in Public Life earning in excess of £100,000 per annum. Your request, which was received on the 2nd March 2010, was dealt with under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I can confirm that the Committee on Standards in Public Life does (and did not) employ anyone (staff, freelance or contractor) paid over £100,000 in the financial years 2008/09 and 2009/10.
