THE SITUATION HAS DETERIORATED SINCE MY LETTER SO I WOULD LIKE TO PROVIDE MY VIEW AS TO HOW THE M.P.S SHOULD CONDUCT THEMSELVES AFTER THE NEXT ELECTION.

1. ALL M.P.S WITHIN 30 MILES OF WESTMINSTER SHOULD COMMUTE TO THE PARLIAMENT.
2. ALL M.P.S UP TO 100 MILES FROM LONDON SHOULD RECEIVE £5000 EXPENSES FOR TRAVEL IF THEY WISH OR £5000 EXPENSES TO A SECOND RESIDENCE.
3. ALL M.P.S OUTSIDE 100 MILES TO RECEIVE £10,000 FOR A SECOND RESIDENCE.
4. ALL EXPENSES PER STAFF, & OFFICE PURCHASES SHOULD BE REDUCED & STAFF AVAILABLE AT A WESTMINSTER OFFICE.
